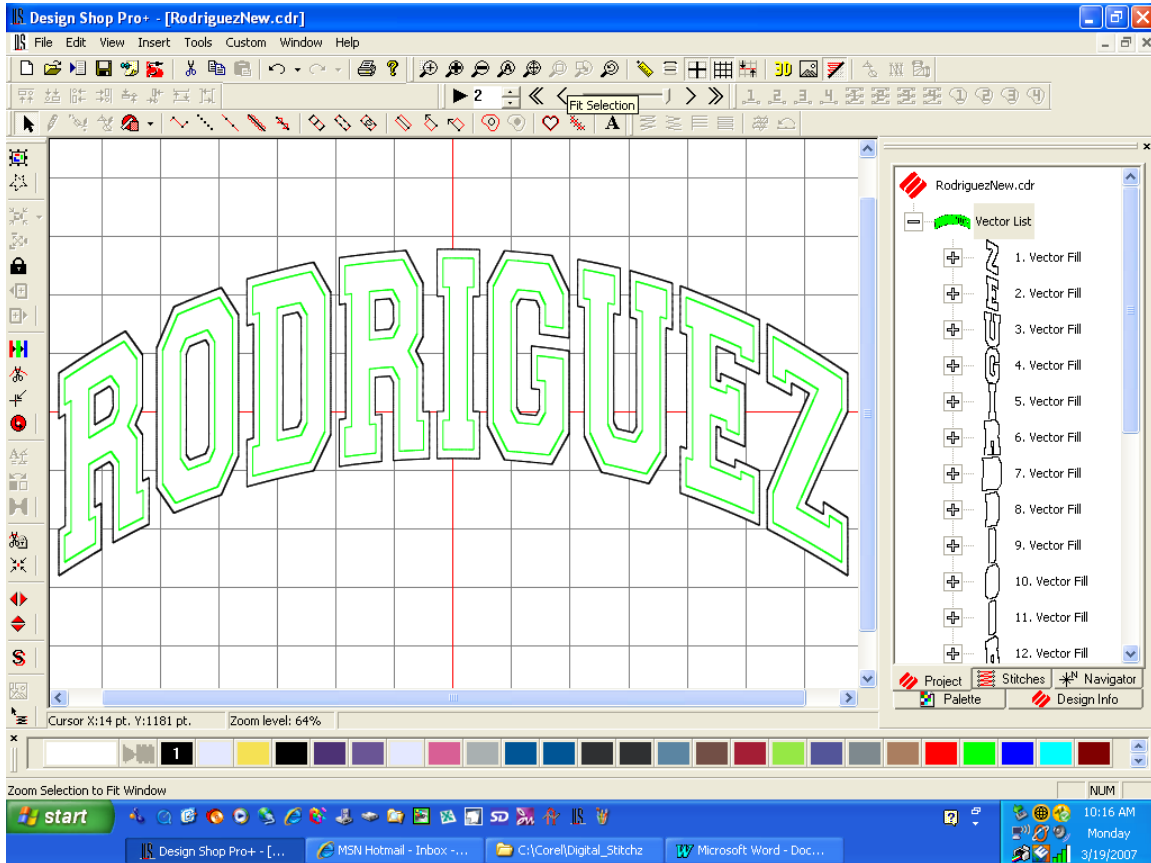
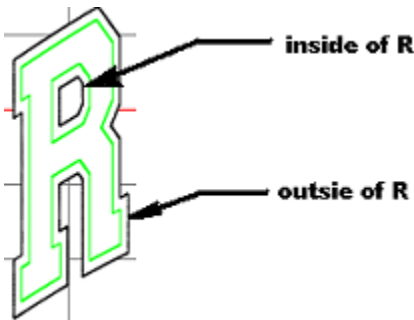


Create Applique for Lettering

Step 1: After loading/opening vector file in Design Shop Plus from CDR(CorelDraw Version 8), EPS(encapsulated postscript) or AI (Adobe Illustrator Version 7), your screen should look similar to this....

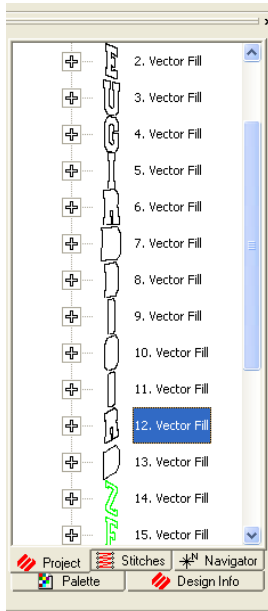


In this example, there two pieces (black) for the “R”, an outside and an inside. Select the outside of the “R”

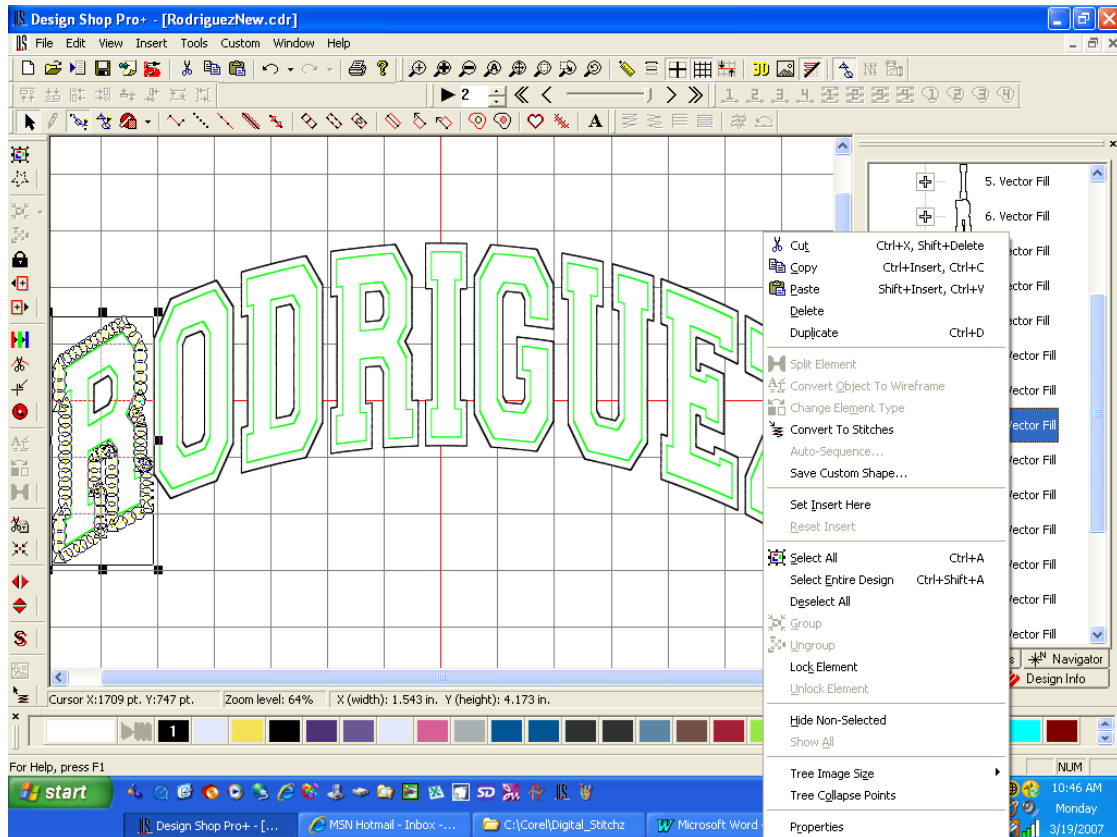


Look at right box, (see below) left mouse click for “R” (12. Vector file).

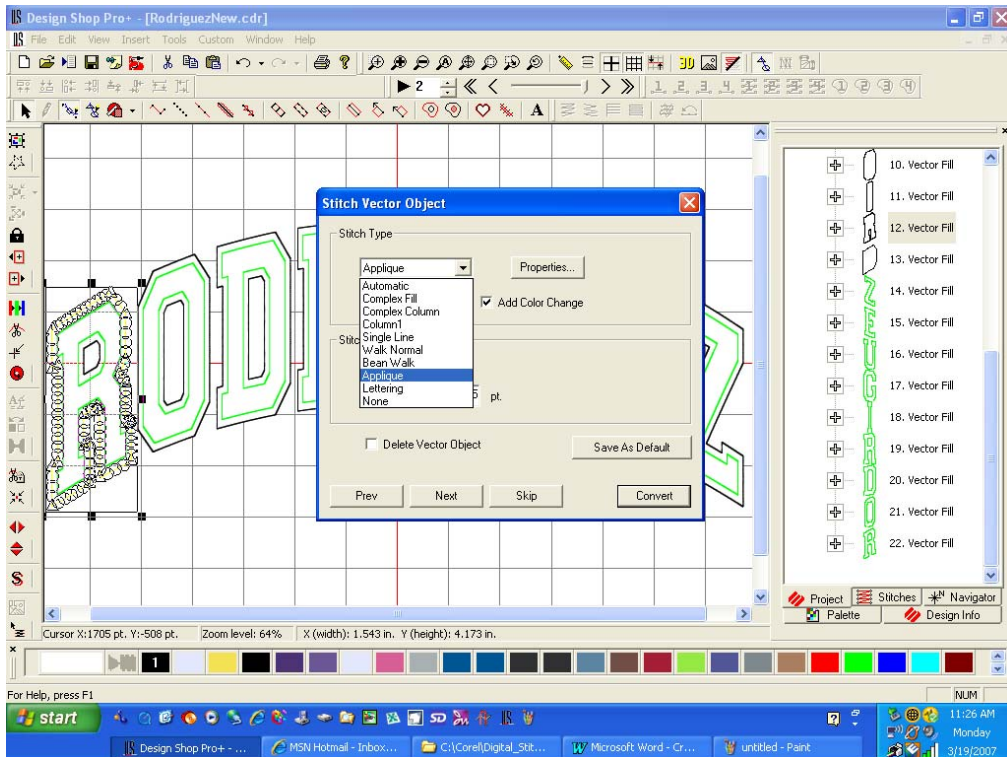
It should look like following box....



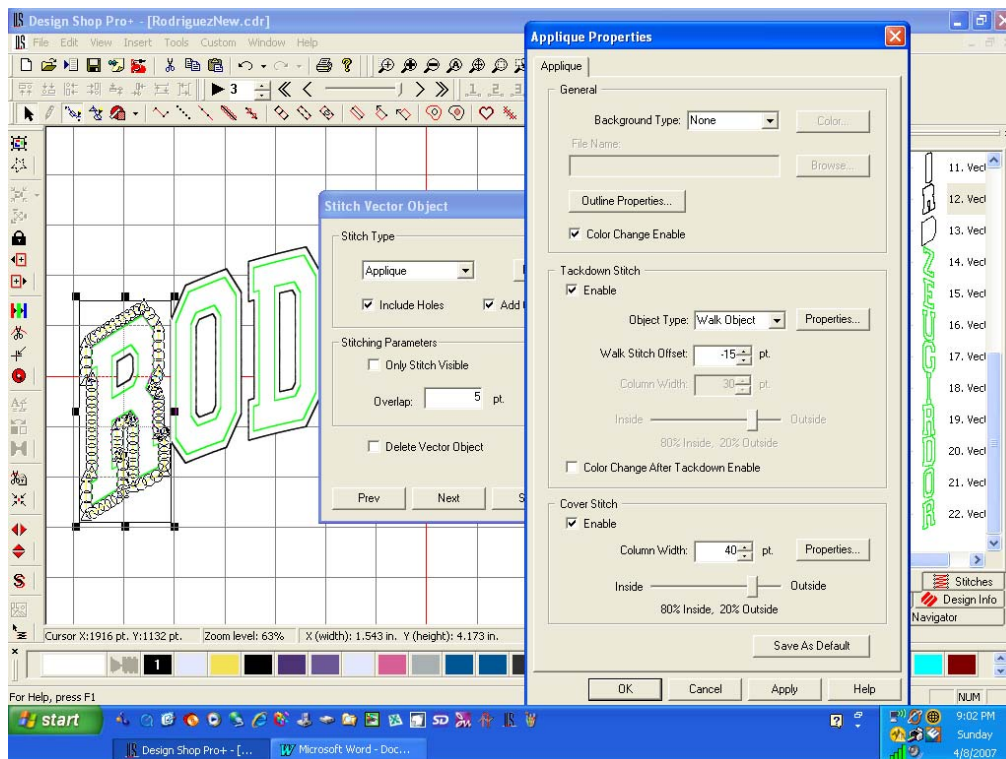
Right mouse click with the cursor over the highlighted (12.Vector file). You should see the following screen.



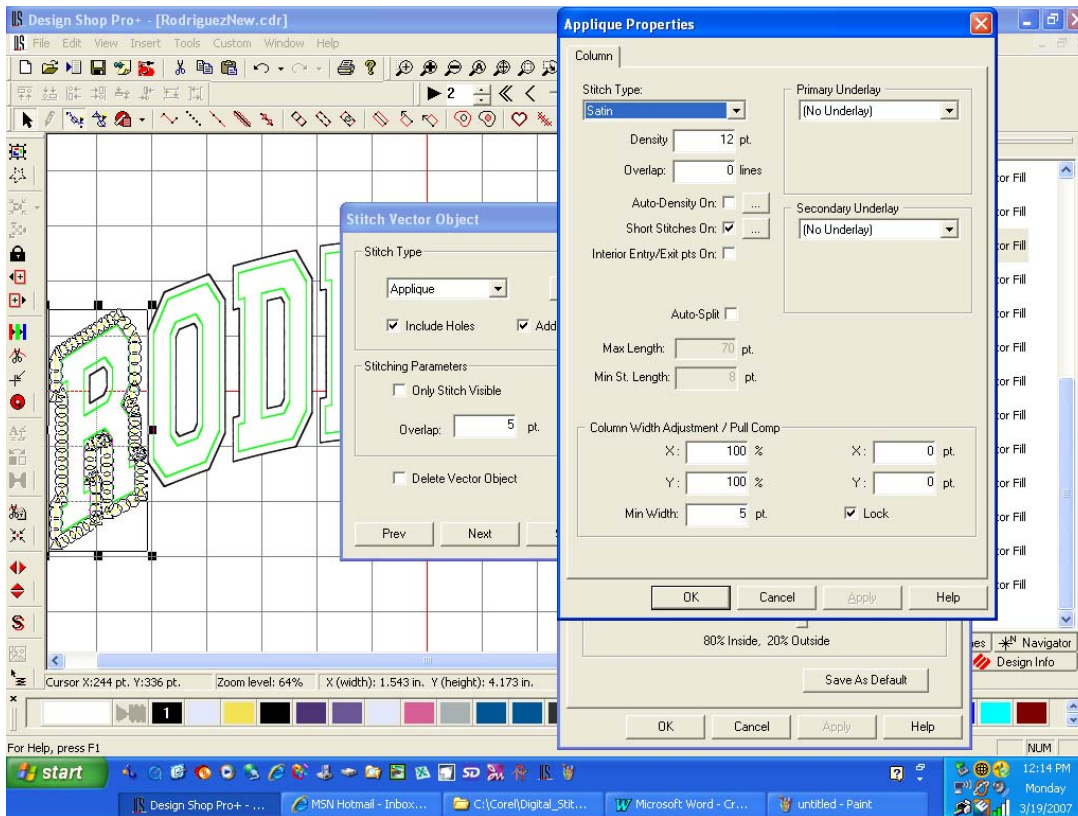
Select **Convert to Stitches** with a left mouse click. This bring up... **STITCH VECTOR OBJECT BOX**.



In Stitch Type pull down menu box choose **Applique**. (As seen above) Then, left mouse click **Properties**.



From the Applique Properties box, First category: **General** the **Background Type** should be *None*. Secondary category: **Tackdown Stitch** the **Enable** box should be checked. The **Object Type** should be *Walk Object*. Look at the third category: **Cover Stitch** the **Enable** box should be checked then, position cursor on the **Column Width Properties** box and left mouse click.



Stitch type should be *Satin* and Density changed to 12. Change Primary Underlay to no underlay. Click Apply, then OK. Again, Click Apply, then OK. Now, you should be back at Stitch Vector Object.
